Kimberly Bianca David (Begay), 34, passed away peacefully on August 23, 2020 with the love of her family surrounding her in Phoenix, AZ after a courageous battle against Covid-19.

As a proud Navajo, Kimberly was born into the Hooghanłání (Many Hogans clan), and born for Txááshcì'i (Red Bottom clan), her maternal grandfather is of the Kinyaá'áaniì (Towering House clan), and paternal grandfather is of the Tótsohnìì (Big Water clan).

Kimberly was known for her enormous heart to help others in any way possible. She had the biggest smile that could light up a room and laughter that was truly contagious.

At a very young age Kimberly fell in love with the game of softball which continued throughout her life. Her determination and passion for the sport shined bright on the field. Even though her stature was tiny, her heart and love for the diamond was beyond words. In 2006, as a brave and selfless human being, Kimberly followed the path of her paternal grandfather, Mike R. Begay Sr. and enlisted in the U.S. Navy where she bravely served our country for 8 years until her honorable discharge. During her dedication of service, she was deployed numerous times to support the war on drugs in El Salvador and placed her life in harm's way during Operation Iraqi Freedom.
